Overview

This contract commenced in January 2016 and will run for up to five years. An excellent mix of both nationwide suppliers and SME's are awarded to the DPS and new suppliers who meet the criteria may join at any time during the contract validity period.

Projects undertaken under this DPS can be funded through a variety of sources including capital funding or the establishment of an Energy Services Company (ESCO) using an Energy Performance Contract following the DECC model contract terms.

For biomass projects only, schools are also able to utilise the Energy Efficiency Financing for Schools Operating Solution offered by Siemens in association with the Carbon Trust. This Operating Solution meets the approval of the Education Funding Agency.
