Framework overview

This is a contractual framework for the supply of early years furniture, incorporating a full space planning, design and support service to allow customers to procure a furniture solution that meets the specific needs of their early years setting.

Who can use this framework?

The Framework Agreement will be open to the entire public sector and other public bodies, such as Local Authorities, Education Establishments, Police Forces, Fire and Rescue Services, NHS Bodies, registered Charities within the UK and central government departments and their agencies that wish to use it. Any other organisation, including but not limited to, Privately Owned Nurseries, Registered Childcare Providers, Children’s centres, Preschools or Playgroups and Early Years Settings in receipt of public funding such as the 30 hours Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE), may utilise the resulting Framework Agreement from the commencement date.

Specification, overview and lot structure

This framework has been designed to offer customers a choice of providers that offer similar product types at different price points and specifications. The framework has two lots with one supplier/provider awarded onto each lot:

Lot 1

Early years furniture – solid wood construction
Supplier/provider: Community Playthings

Lot 2

Early years furniture – MDF construction
Supplier/provider: Millhouse

Both suppliers/providers can offer a complete space planning and design service and have an extensive product range that includes:

This reduces procurement risk for customers and reduces bureaucracy in the procurement process
- Assured supplier/provider standards – suppliers/providers appointed onto this framework are 'pre-qualified' as to their general suitability meaning customers can be assured that they can meet specified requirements
- Aggregation of spend – customers will receive the benefits of an aggregated volume of spend and the benefits associated with an increased leverage on the market
- Pre-defined terms and conditions – providers have agreed to YPO's standard framework agreement terms and conditions

Framework agreement

In addition to offering competitive pricing, suppliers/providers were required to demonstrate their capabilities of delivering the requirements of this framework by answering a series of questions relating to quality, sustainability, delivery and customer service.

The award criteria/weightings used to establish this framework are detailed below:

Terms and conditions

Suppliers/providers awarded to the framework agreement have agreed to and signed YPO's standard Terms and Conditions.
