Highways England is a Government company responsible for modernising and maintaining UK motorways and major A roads.

Having recently undergone a large transformational project, the UK Highways Agency became Highways England. At the heart of this transformation, is a plan to invest £11 billion in UK highways and add 1,300 miles of new lanes.

To support these ambitious changes, they planned to move away from their long-term outsourced IT services as part of the Cabinet Office disaggregation programme.

In order to meet Government standards, and tie in with the programme, Highways England chose to use Government accredited SCC hosting services.

As the longest established provider of Pan-Government accredited secure IL2 and IL3 Cloud services in the UK, the agreement saw SCC migrate approximately 300 Highways England servers into its Cloud environment and host their back office infrastructure, supporting almost 4,000 users.

This was done using the Sentinel by SCC secure hosting platform, which ensures data security to CESG IL2 and IL3 standards.

Highways England chose SCC as their hosting partner, as they offered the lowest-risk migration from their previous provider ensuring uninterrupted standards of operation. Other important factor was SCC's ability to migrate these services to tight schedules and offer a broader range of services beyond hosting.
