Lot Specification advertised at tender stage:

Lot 1: Self-Heating Meals

Description/Requirement

- Self-heating meals, designed to be heated when there are no other means available to heat the food. The pack should include everything required to heat the meal, contained all in one pack. The meals should be ready to eat in less than 20 minutes, nutritious and exceed 70 °c (or the relevant temperature for the foods contained). A range of foods must be offered to offer choice for the user, we are evaluating a small range at ITT stage. The meal should substitute a hot meal when there are no other options for a hot meal and be a minimum of 300grams.
- Vegetarian and vegan options must be available.
- Products should be supplied pre-packaged and fully labelled following the most relevant legislations and labelling standards.
- The pack must include everything to heat the meal and contain clear instructions on how to do this.

1	Breakfast Dish – e.g All day breakfast
2	Vegetable Dish – e.g Vegetable Curry
3	Pasta Dish – e.g. Spaghetti Bolognaise
4	Meat Dish – e.g. Chicken Casserole



Lot 2: Self-Heating Ration Packs

Description/Requirement

- Self-heating Ration Packs, designed to be heated when there are no other means available to heat and/or obtain the food and beverages. The pack should include everything required to heat the meals contained all in one pack. The Ration Packs should be ready to consume in less than 20 minutes, nutritious and exceed 70°C (or the relevant temperature for the food and beverages contained). A range of options must be offered to offer choice for the user, we are evaluating a small range at ITT stage.
- Vegetarian and vegan options must be available.
- Products should be supplied pre-packaged and fully labelled following the most relevant legislations and labelling standards.
- The Ration Pack must include everything to heat the meal/s, contain clear instructions on how to do this and include sundry items such as disposable cutlery and tissues.

*YPO will allow suppliers to provide products with a variance of +/- 10% of the Kcals detailed below.

**The Ration Pack contents listed below are examples of what is expected of a typical ration pack to include. The list is not exhaustive or limited to.

Lot 3: Beverages, Snacks and Supplements

Description/Requirement

- Snacks and supplements. A range of foods must be offered to offer choice for the user, we are evaluating a small range at ITT stage.
- Vegetarian and vegan options must be available.
- Products should be supplied pre-packaged and fully labelled following the most relevant legislations and labelling standards.

1	Drink pack – e.g. 2 tea, 2 coffee, 4 creamers and 4 sugars
2	Energy/electrolyte drink powder/fruit flavoured drink powder
3	High energy snack bars/biscuits/flapjack – e.g. Protein
4	Cutlery (Sample required)

How to award/call-off

To access the framework agreement, customers should complete and return the Non-Disclosure and Customer Access Agreement.

Direct award

Customers will form a call-off contract between themselves and the supplier/provider.

The selection/award criteria used to establish the framework agreement was:

Criterion	Percentage weightings
Cost	30%
Quality	40%
Delivery and Customer Service	20%
Social Value/Sustainability	10%

Terms and conditions

Suppliers/providers awarded to the framework agreement have agreed to and signed YPO's standard Terms and Conditions. These can be amended by the CA and supplier/provider by mutual agreement to include

additional terms to supplement the standard Terms and Conditions. A variation form is included in the standard Terms and Conditions document to allow customers and suppliers/providers to amend any terms if required.
